

## Low Dose Naltrexone for Veterinary Use/Quick Order Form

◆ What is Low Dose Naltrexone?

Low Dose Naltrexone (LDN) can be used in animals for a variety of conditions such as pain, autoimmune conditions, canine compulsive disorder, mood disorders, cancer, arthritis, inflammation, seizures and skin disorders. LDN can be prescribed for canines, felines, piglets, and even farm animals.

◆ Behavioral Issues

Dogs with behavioral issues can take the medication, often in an oral liquid. Studies have shown that LDN can benefit dogs with obsessive compulsive disorders, or tail chasing and other conditions.

◆ LDN Dosing (BID dosing may be needed for fast metabolism)

10 lbs or less – 1mg  
11 – 19 lbs – 1.5mg  
20 – 30 lbs – 2mg  
31 – 45 lbs – 3mg  
46 – 75 lbs – 4mg  
76 lbs and greater – 4.5mg
